	Problems identified:
	- parents lack information about their rights and where to turn for help;
	<ul> <li>a lack of knowledge and understanding amond police officers about the specific nature of the investigation of sexual abuse cases against children;</li> </ul>
	- judging attitude, especially in cases when the victim is a teenager;
	- Insufficient exchange of information between police, social service and crisis center, which leads to uncoordinated actions
	- There is no common and unite practice used for interviewing children.
