<p>9.00-10.30</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduction of the participants; • Introducing new service in Barnahus work with sexual abuse grey cases - exploratory interview. <p>Participants are introduced with Recommendations developed in Promise II project and planned pilot of the new method in Center Dardedze together with Riga Social service in 6 month period April – October 2019.</p> <p>Recommendations are based on Barnahus 10 standards and mapping results after pilot year in 2017.</p> <p>Participants together discuss the scheme mechanism in cases of child sexual abuse. Dardedze presents the findings in focus groups in 4 crisis centers.</p> <p>Based on the results from focus groups, Recommendations developed in Promise II and Barnahus 10 standards, in Badev project experts develop a scheme mechanism (algorithm) on cooperation between crisis center (future regional Barnahus) with child rights protection and law enforcement in detecting and investigating cases of child sexual abuse.</p> <p>Participants discuss the legal framework and define the order of interventions in accordance with the best interests of the child victim.</p> <p>Scheme mechanism draft version will be ready in May and later will be published as a set of four booklets(guidelines) for professionals dealing with child sexual abuse victims</p> <p>Questions, discussion</p>

11.00 – 13.00	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Experience and prevention programs of sexual abuse against children in UK (Donald Findlater, Lucy Faithfull Foundation) PPT presentation <p>D. Findlater introduces participants to the programs used in UK.</p> <p>Participants discuss the actual interventions and operating systems in Latvia in cases of sexual abuse against children according to Smallbone sexual abuse prevention framework</p> <p>Ministry of Justice introduces participants with the sexual abuse against children prevention plan for years 2019-2020.</p> <p>Ministry of Welfare inform about the progress in discussions with EEZ financial instrument. The agreement would possible be signed in the autumn 2019, project will last for 5 years. It is decided to re-open Barnahus in ther theritory of University Children hospital as there is money planned in the project for renovation.</p> <p>Participants discuss the further actions in cooperation as no extra budget is aprooved for actions in the plan.</p> <p>Dardedze informes about ongoing training across Latvia for joint teams in crisis centers and and multisectoral groups from municipalities. 160 perople will be trained according to the activities plan.</p> <p>Participants discuss the necessary steps for further implemetation of Barnahus and the necessary changes in the law.</p> <p>Participants agree to share information regularly and decide to develop a joint summary of current developments in the area of prevention of sexual abuse against children.
